## **Easter Cockerel Instructions**





Step 1: You will need a paper plate, colouring pens/pencils/crayons, a glue stick, sticky tape, a pencil, scissors and a piece of paper.




If you do not have a paper plate you can draw around a plate on a piece of card/paper, and then cut it out



Step 2: Colour the plate in stripes of yellow, orange and red like the picture.



Step 3: Fold the plate in half so that you can see all 3 colours.



Step 4: Now on your A4 piece of paper draw and colour the blocks and circles as shown in the picture.




Step 5: On the orange block draw a triangle as shown.



Step 6: Cut it out to make the beak. Then fold it in half.





Step 7: Stick the beak underneath at the fold on the yellow end (see picture) so that you can see the orange beak sticking out. At the same time cut out your black circles and stick them on for eyes (1 each side).



Step 8: On the large yellow rectangle draw 2 large feathers and 4 small ones.



**Step 9: Now cut the feathers out.** 




Step 10: Stick 1 big feather and 2 small feathers each side.




Step 11: Draw a Comb (a bit like a crown) in the red rectangle, cut it out and then colour the other side of it.



Step 12: Stick the comb at the top, on the fold, above the eye. So that it sticks out at the top.




Step 13: To make the tail cut out the strip of 3 colours.



Step 14: Now cut down the length of each colour about 2/3rds of the way. DONOT CUT ALL THE WAY TO THE END.



Step 15: Turn over the plate so that the inside is facing you. Now using the sticky tape stick the tail to the under side of the plate with the coloured side facing away from you.



You should now have an Easter Cockerel. Final Step: Now write out the following bible verse on the inside of your cockerel (or ask an adult to help you)

**'Immediately a cock crowed. Then Peter remembered the** word Jesus had spoken "Before the cock crows you will disown me three times." And he went outside and wept bitterly." Matthew chapter 26 verse 74 & 75.

Well Done you have finished you can now use this as part of you Easter decorations and celebrations.
